## Item No 1: Review of previous minutes:

The previous meeting minutes were reviewed.

## Item No 2: Placement drives and training:

The Convener conveyed that the Placement Cell in the College is functioning effectively. Nearly 60% of the students got placements in reputed companies in the country.

## Item No 3: Progress in Autonomous application:

As we received NOC from JNTUH, Proposals for Autonomous Functioning is in Progress such as

- Determining its own courses of study and syllabi.
- Prescribing rules for admission in consonance with the reservation policy of the state government.
- Evolving methods of assessments of students and Conduct of examinations.
- Promoting Extension Activities and developing projects for the benefit of the society etc.

## Item No 4: Internships of B. Fech and Diploma students:

During internships, students are provided with opportunities to apply what they learned in classes to actual practice. It is expected that students will also be challenged to examine how their attitudes, beliefs, and values influence the helping process. In accepting students as interns, the agency/facility representative recognizes that the internship is a learning process designed to promote professional growth of the students. As a result most of the IV year B.Tech students pursued their MINI Projects through internships.

## Item No 5: Review of I,II,III and IV year B. Tech Results:

Academic Results of all branches of 2017-18 and 2018-19 were discussed. Extra classes for weak students have been held for all batches and hopefully 2019-20 results will show a marked improvement.

#### Item No 6: Examination Reforms

The question papers for the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) are set by the internal faculty. The question papers of the CIE are scrutinized by the HoD along with Subject Expert. A system of central valuation is adopted for the theory courses involving internal examiners where the faculty handling the subjects are intimated and directed to prepare the Question Bank (with Blooms Taxonomy) and it has to be submitted to questionank@stpetershyd.com\_within the stipulated period specified by the Exam Cell. For the practical courses the evaluation is done by a panel of internal and external examiners. If the student is not satisfied with the results after evaluation, they can apply for review of the answer script.

## Item No 7 Commencement of MOOCs Courses from SWAYAM Platform:

Now SPEC is a Local Chapter in SWAYAM-NPTEL Platform. The courses hosted on SWAYAM are in 4 quadrants - (1) video lecture, (2) specially prepared reading material that can be downloaded/printed (3) self-assessment tests through tests and quizzes and (4) an online discussion forum for clearing the doubts. Students have registered in various courses for enriching their learning experiences by using state of art Technology.

#### Item No 8: Grants received from AICTE, EDII, TEQIP:

- Dr. Diana Moses Professor, CSE received Rs. 11.4 Lacs for the Skill and Personality Development Programme for SC/ST Students from AICTE. The duration of the Programme is 2019-2022. Room Number F4 is identified to give training under the same.
- Dr.Padmanadham Professor, ECE received Rs.9.58 Lacs for MODERNISATION AND REMOVAL OF OBSOLENSCENCE (MODROBS) for Embedded Systems Lab from AICTE. The duration of the Programme is 2019-2021. The Convener conveyed that the equipment is also procured & MODROS in Progress.
- Dr.Rajasekhar Professo, CSE received Rs. 2.8 Lacs as the Grant for Organizing Conference Programme from AICTE. It is jointly conducted by CSE,ECE,EEE Departments of SPEC. The duration of the Programme is 2019-2020.
- Dr.Sharadha Varalakshmi HoD,CSE received Rs. 3 Lacs for the project titled "Identification of Sickle Cell Anemia using Deep Neural Network" under Collaborative Research Scheme, TEQIP III, JNTUH as Co supervisor.

## Item No 9: New courses and Infrastructural requirement:

It is discussed to opt for new courses like Artificial Intelligence (AI) and to increase intake in Information Technology (IT) from 60 to 120 for the academic year 2020-21 and to close M.Tech CSE and M.Tech Machine Design under post graduate level. It is also discussed for the reduction of certain courses at under graduate level i.e., Mechanical Engineering From 120 to 60 and Electronics and Communication Engineering from 180 to 120 subject to the approval of new course i.e. Artificial Intelligence (AI).

Convener Conveyed that beautification, Renovation and Repair works are in Progress in view of Autonomous status.
